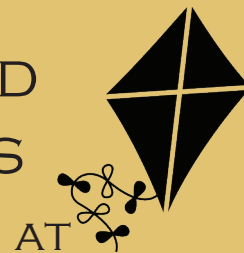

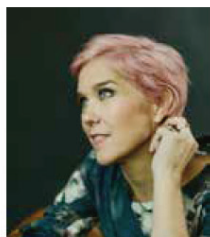

## Theta Travel Sisters

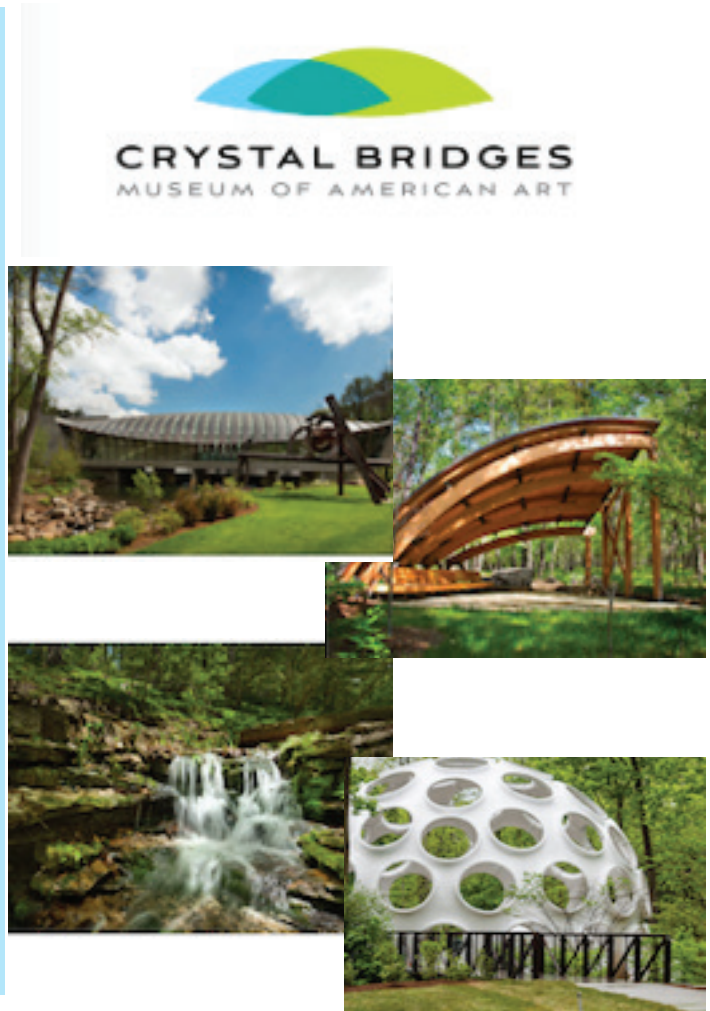

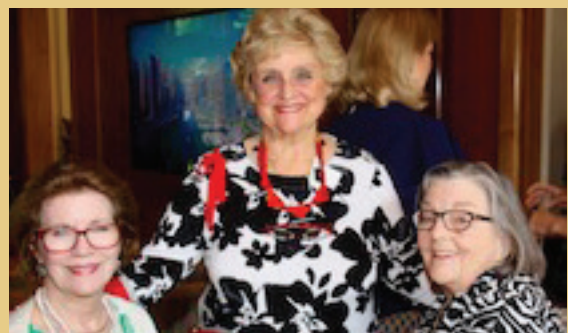

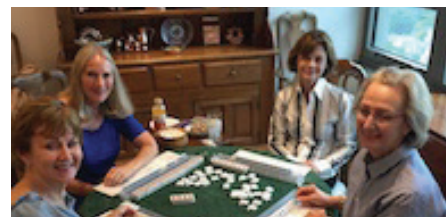
