Every spring, volunteers are needed to read and score scholarship applications from Thetas across the country. There were many volunteers who signed up on our dues form Interest List last fall. Do you recall if YOU signed up? If so, **Christie Parker** (cnp713@outlook.com, 713-553-3466) is Chairman of the ARC Committee this year, and she would love to hear from you. You can also sign up now if you missed signing up in the fall.

This volunteer job requires 5-10 hours of your time over a 2 1/2 week period, from March 19th-April 7th. You will be so impressed with the young women who are applying for scholarships, and furthering their educational opportunities. The applications are all read online, and the scores you give each applicant are tallied with other volunteers' scores to give a total point number to each applicant. All work is done at your convenience, in your home or office. There are no meetings to attend!

This is truly a meaningful way to give back to Theta, and to these young women. Here are quotes from some of this year's recipients, along with their photos.
